**Hot:** having a lot of heat.

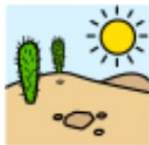


**Physical Geography**

**Cold:** having little heat.



**Desert:** a very dry, hot place

**Human Geography**

- ★ People in cold places wear **thick clothes** and live in **warm homes**
- ★ People in hot places wear **light clothes** and use **shade**
- ★ Different transport is used (sleds in cold places, camels in deserts)

**Physical Geography**



- ★ Cold places have **snow, ice, and icebergs**
- ★ Hot places can have **sand, deserts, rainforests, and strong sun**
- ★ Different animals live in hot and cold climates
