Village/Settlement – A place where people lived together.

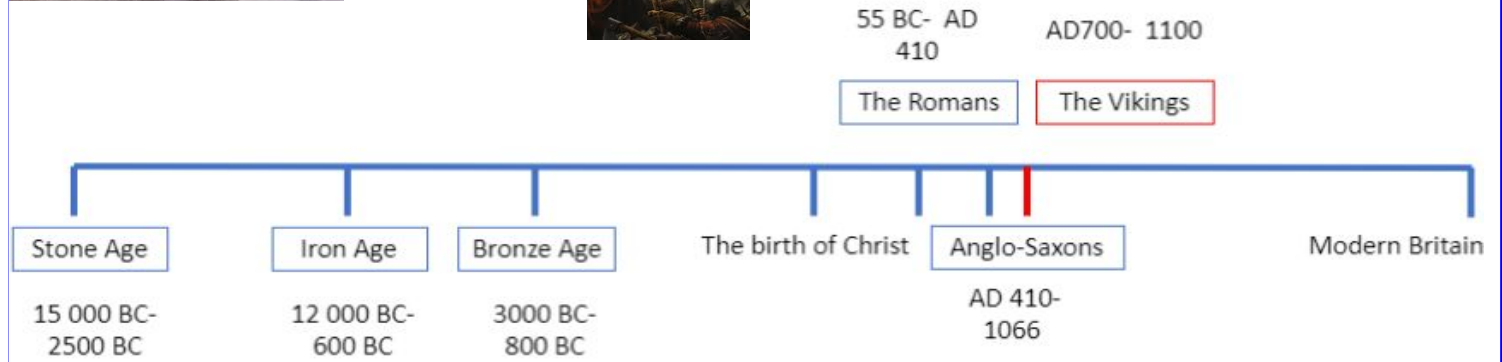
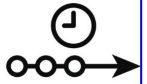
Norse – Another word used to describe Vikings.
