

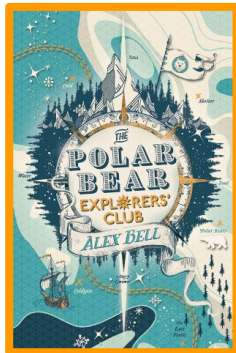
## English

## Connected Curriculum Frozen Frontiers
