Civilisation – A group of people living together with laws, culture, and organised society.

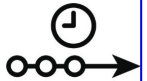
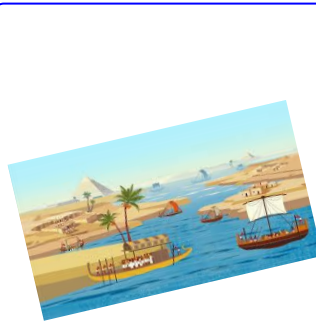
Pharaoh – The ruler of Ancient Egypt, seen as a god on Earth.

Nile – The longest river in the world, which was very important for farming and life in Egypt.

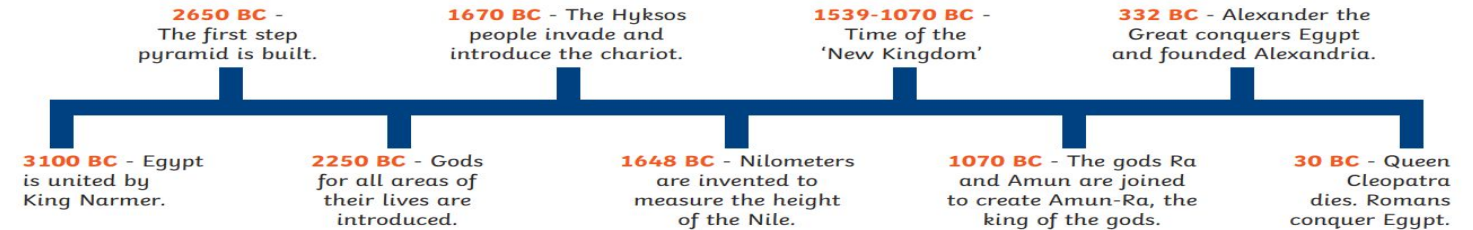
Scribe – A person who was trained to read and write hieroglyphics and record information.

Pyramid – A large stone structure built as a tomb for pharaohs and important people.
