**Biodiversity** – The variety of plants and animals living in an area.

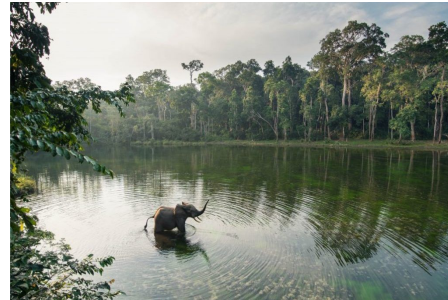
**Adaptation** – A feature that helps a plant or animal survive in its habitat.

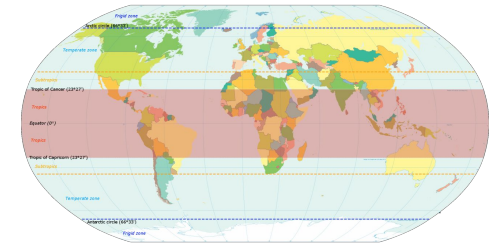

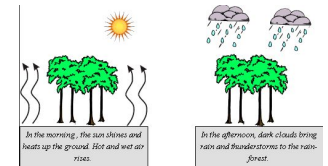
