In Term 1, we are going to begin by focusing on basic writing skills. We are going to recognise what a sentence is, how it starts with a capital letter and ends with a full stop. We are going to be writing our own sentences that are coherent and demarcated with appropriate punctuation and finger spaces used throughout. We are then going to be exploring our core text for this term 'The Great Fire of London - Illustrated History' by Emma Adams. We are going to be learning the skills required to write a setting description about London during the Great Fire of London.

In Term 1 we begin learning about **God**. Our big question for this unit is 'What do Christians believe God is like? We will begin by exploring the big frieze and exploring a range of parables, discussing the lesson/moral they provide.

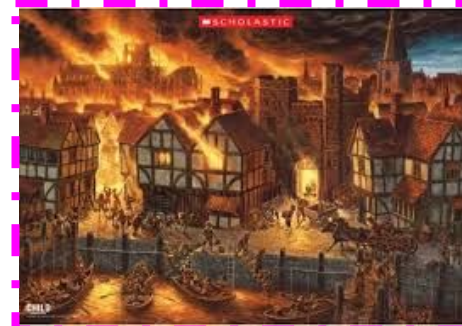
Learning Overview
