#### Vocabulary:



**Country** – a nation with its own government and territory.

**County** – an administrative division within a country or state.

**City** – a large, permanent settlement, often with administrative or economic importance.

**Town** – a smaller settlement than a city but larger than a village.

**Village** – a small settlement, usually rural.

**Capital** – the city where a government is based.

**District** – a defined administrative area within a city, county, or country.
