**Celts:** People living in Britain in tribes during the time of the Roman invasions

**Emperor:** The ruler of an Empire

**Empire:** A group of countries controlled by one

ruler (emperor or empress) or government

**Legion:** A large section of the Roman army, made

up of around 5000 soldiers.

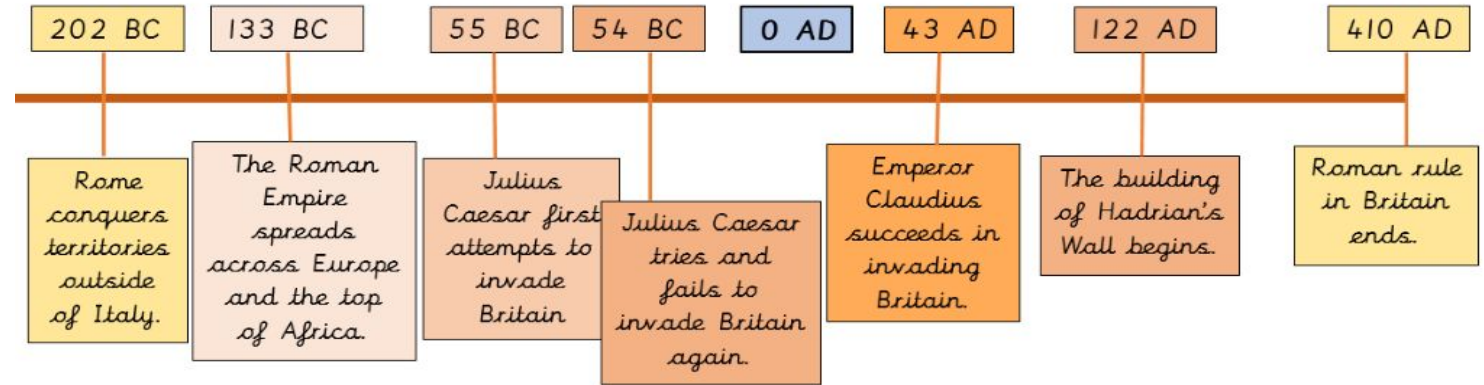
**Invade:** to enter another country by force

**Conquer:** Taking control of a place by force, often

with an army.

**Centurion** – the leader of a group of 100 soldiers
