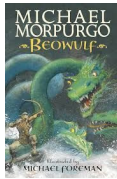


English



In English this term, our focus text will be **Beowulf**, which links closely to our History topic – **Invaders from the North**.

Children will use the story to inspire their own writing, including a **diary entry** and a **piece of persuasive writing**.

Throughout the term, we will be developing key writing skills such as using the **first person, past tense adverbials, noun phrases, and expanded noun phrases** to add detail and interest to their work.

Maths

This term in Year 4, we will be finishing our work on **addition and subtraction**, where children are building confidence using efficient written methods.

Next, we will move on to exploring **area**, learning how to measure and compare the size of different shapes.

Finally, we'll begin our new unit on **multiplication and division**, focusing on understanding number patterns and applying these skills in a range of contexts.

Learning Overview

Throughout Term 2, we will be learning about **Incarnation** and exploring our big question: **"What is the Trinity?"**

Children will develop their understanding of the Christian belief that God is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. They will learn how the Trinity is represented in the Bible and in Christian worship, and reflect on why this belief is important to Christians today.

PE

This term, our **PE lessons** will take place on **Mondays and Thursdays**. Children will be developing their **Hockey skills** with our sports coach and also taking part in **Dance**, focusing on rhythm, movement, and teamwork.

On **Wednesdays**, we will have our weekly **Forest School** session. Please ensure children come to school dressed in their **appropriate Forest School clothes**, with **wellies and coats** packed and ready for all weather conditions.



Connected Curriculum

Invaders From the North

This term in History, we will be exploring the question: **"What was life like for the Anglo-Saxons and Scots?"**

Children will learn about **where the Anglo-Saxons came from** and why they settled in Britain. We'll explore **what their homes, villages, and daily life were like**, and how their society was organised. Finally, we'll look at **the struggle for power in Britain**, learning about key leaders and events that shaped this fascinating period of history.
