Invasion – when people from another land attack and try to take over.

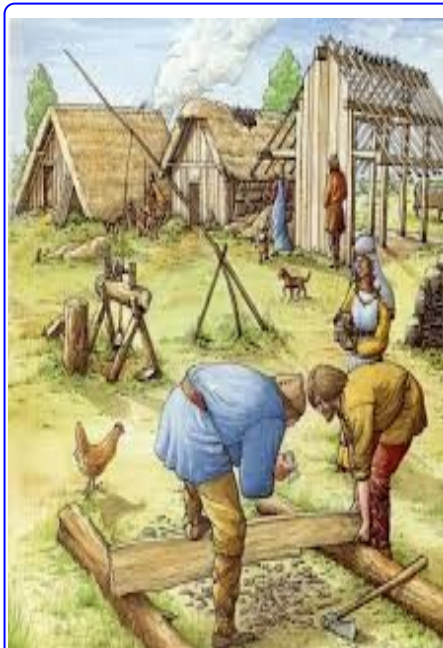
Shield – something a warrior held to protect himself.
