## Term 1 - Home Learning Project

### Science

Animals and their habitats.

Which kind of habitat does your animal come from?

What does your chosen animal need to be cared for, or protected?

What does it eat, and what are its teeth like?  
Does it have prey, or predators?

What is its life-cycle?

### Art

Have any artists drawn your chosen animal?

Can you create some art work, or could you make a model?

## The Challenge

### Become an animal expert!

This term, Idris' home learning challenge supports our learning across the curriculum: Animal and their Habitats.

You are going to create a project all about your favourite type of animal. This can be a pet or a wild animal and you can choose the way that you teach the class all about it. For example, you may write a book, or a leaflet, you can include photographs or drawings. The main thing is to make it as interesting as you can because, in the week of Monday 30<sup>th</sup> October, you will be presenting your work to the class.

### Maths

Measurements: What size can your animal grow up to?  
How big is it compared to a human.  
If you learn all about your pet, how much does it weigh?

Time: What is the life expectancy of your animal?

### English

Research the different things you could do for the project.

Write an information text about your chosen animal.

Are there any famous members of your animal group?

Has your animal featured in any poems, or can you write one?

Ask an expert. Could you interview someone about your animal? For example, a vet or even a zoo keeper?
